


## **Activity time (10 minutes)**

### Fill the pot Make a hole in Cover the hole Water well and When the with compost the compost with more keep in a seedling has using your compost greenhouse or grown up to fingers, pop a windowsill 15cm, plant seed or two outside, water **Instructions** into the hole to plant Outdoor Make sure the soil is free from weed and grass sunflower Drill 12mm holes into the soil, keep each seed 20cm apart Cover the hole with soil, add organic matter on top or garden compost seed Water well until seedlings are established Thin plants to keep them 40 cm apart from each other when they grow, to prevent overcrowding To protect from snails or slugs, cover with a plastic bottle

# Oak Tree (Native Irish) Planting Instructions

- · Minimum space required: 3m from any other tree
- Soil type: sandy soil and clay, should not be wet soil
- · Get a spade, dig at least 6-7 inches deep into soil
- Insert the cell in hole and cover back with soil
- · Position of the sapling should be straight enough
- · Water every week, protect from rabbits
